Notification by Chief of Police Anthony Marraccini that the New York State Department of Transportation has granted the Town’s request from 2007 to install two school zone warning beacons on Route 127 in the vicinity of Harrison Avenue School. The NYS Department of Transportation will maintain the signal for an annual fee of \$1,251.62. It is the Chiefs recommendation that the Town Board accept this agreement.

3. Request by Commissioner of Public Works Anthony Robinson for approval to have the Commercial Garbage Program arrears and associated penalties added to the 2010 Assessment Roll. All outstanding properties were notified by the Law Department on September 10, 2010 of the resolution that was passed imposing a \$150 penalty and the authorization to impose a lien on the property for those that failed to pay outstanding charges by October 1, 2010. **(Attachment to follow) Further requested** that the Board authorize the Assessor to set up two separate districts to process the collection fee separately from the penalty.
