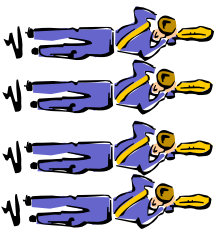

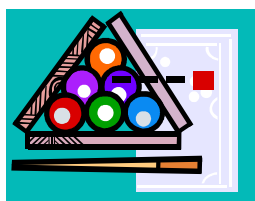

- Players moving up to new age groupings will not be moved with former teammates as a group and will be re-distributed; please refrain from making special requests for team placement. (Excludes K-2<sup>nd</sup> grades)
