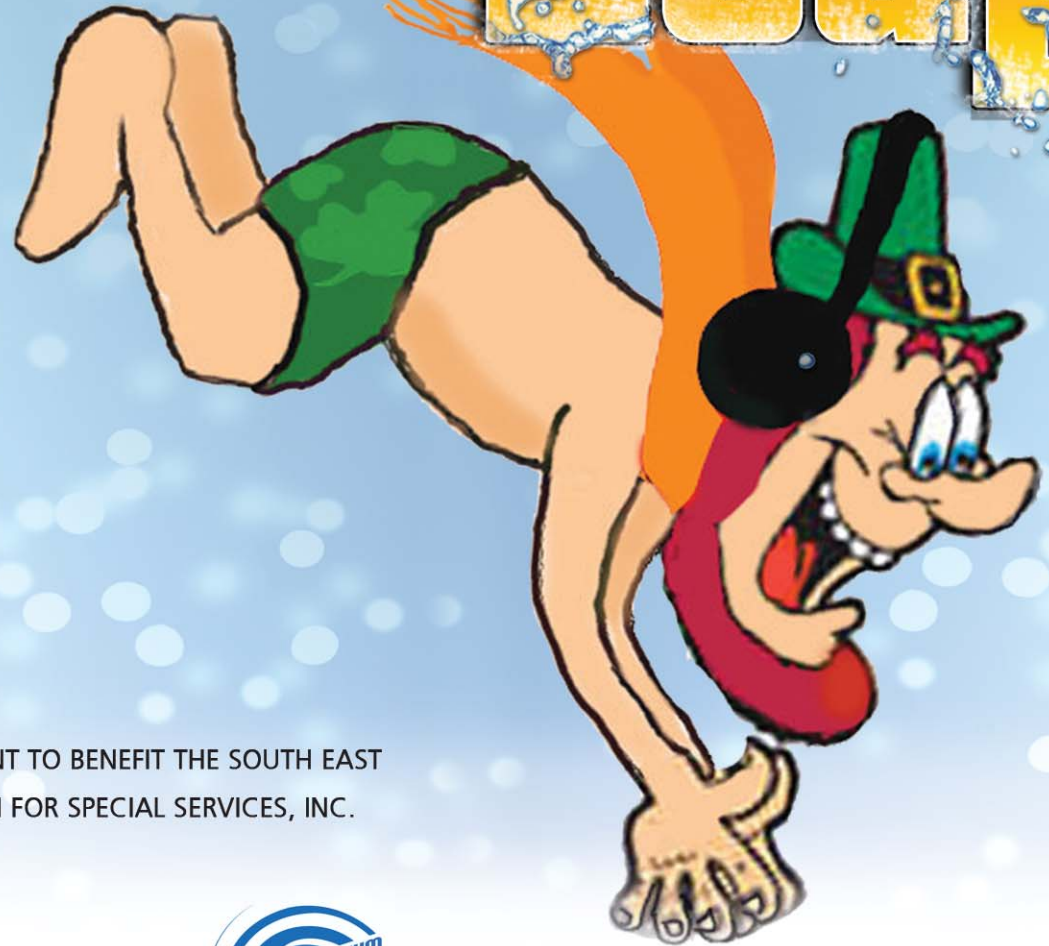
## What is the South East Consortium?

Created in 1981, the South East Consortium for Special Services, Inc. is a 501 c (3) not-for-profit organization dedicated to providing therapeutic recreation services, leisure-related programs and respite opportunities to over 350 children and adults with special needs who reside in southeastern Westchester County. South East serves primarily families residing in the City of Rye, Town of Harrison, Town of Pelham, Town of Eastchester, Village of Scarsdale, Village of Port Chester, Village of Rye Brook, Town of Mamaroneck and the Village of Mamaroneck.

## How will your participation help South East?

A significant portion of the South East operating budget each year depends on raising money with donations and hosting special events such as the Leprechaun Leap. Approximately 85% of all money raised by South East goes directly to providing programs and services. Your donation is tax deductible to the extent allowed by law. RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, AND INDEMNITY,  
AND PARENTAL CONSENT AGREEMENT (“AGREEMENT”)**

In consideration of participating in the **Leprechaun Leap** for the South East Consortium for Special Services, Inc., I represent that I understand the nature of the **Leprechaun Leap** event and that I and/or my minor child am qualified, in good health, and in proper physical condition to participate in such Activity. I acknowledge that if I and/or my child believe event conditions are unsafe, I and/or my minor child will immediately discontinue participation in the Activity.

I fully understand that the **Leprechaun Leap** involve risks of serious bodily injury, including permanent disability, paralysis and death, which may be caused by my own actions, or inactions, those of others participating in the event, the conditions in which the event takes place, or the negligence of the “Releasees” names below; and that there may be other risks either not known to me or not readily foreseeable at this time; and I fully accept and assume all such risks and all responsibility for losses, costs, and damages I and/or my minor child incur as a result of my and/or minor child’s participation in the Activity.

I hereby release, discharge, and covenant not to sue the South East Consortium for Special Services, Inc., its respective administrators, directors, agents, officers, volunteers and employees, other participants, any sponsors, advertisers, and, if applicable, owners and lessors of premises on which the Activity takes place (each considered one of the “Releasees” herein) from all liability claims, demands, losses, or damages on my account caused alleged to be caused whole or in part by the negligence of the “Releasees” or otherwise including negligent rescue operations; and I further agree that if, despite this release, waiver of liability, and assumption of risk I, or anyone on my and/or my minor child’s behalf, makes a claim against any of the “Releasees”, I will indemnify, save, and hold harmless each of the “Releasees” from any loss, liability, damage, or cost which may be incurred as the result of such claim.

**I have read this Release and Waiver of Liability, Assumption of Risk, and Indemnity Agreement, and Parent Consent Agreement**, understand that I have given up substantial rights by signing it and have signed it freely and without any inducement or assurance of any nature and intend it be a complete and unconditional release of all liability to the greatest extent allowed by law and agree that if any portion of this agreement is held to be invalid the balance, notwithstanding, shall continue in full force and effect.
