



## **I-287 Stage III Project Update**

### **At the Ramp "U" over I-287 Bridge:**

#### **Center Pier Demolition Takes Place Tonight During Overnight Operations, With Elevated Noise Levels to Cease by Midnight;**

#### **Continued Abutment Demolition and Removal Is Upcoming During Day-Time Shifts**

*With deck demolition and steel beam removal having been completed during the last few weeks, much of the work on this structure has focused on the remainder of the abutment and pier demolition of the pre-existing Ramp "U" structure.*

*While abutment and some pre-existing pier demolition and clearing continue during day-time operations, tonight's overnight shift should accomplish the demolition of the center pier from the preexisting structure. In the next few weeks, the remainder of any abutment and pier demolition and clearing should be completed during day-time shifts, with little, if any noise or traffic impacts.*

*This work may create elevated noise levels to residents living within close proximity. However, any loud banging will be limited to midnight. Residents may be assured that every effort will be made to mitigate against any potential impacts.*

*Located between Exits 8W and 8E, the new Ramp "U" has been opened to traffic and connects Bloomingdale Road with I-287 westbound roadway. The new ramp is expected to remain open during these operations.*

*Area motorists are advised to proceed with caution and observe posted speed limits while following directional signage as they travel through this work zone. Temporary lane closures will be implemented on the I-287 eastbound roadway as needed. Project flagging personnel will assist in facilitating safe and fluid traffic flows through this work zone.*

*Project staff will do its utmost to complete this work as quickly and efficiently as possible. The new ramp area will undergo continued completion work.*
