JUNIOR SOCCER LEAGUE: Open to boys and girls in grades 2nd - 8th starting September 21st and end November 2nd

DIAMOND DREAMS BASEBALL CAMP: A week of instruction stressing the fundamentals, proper techniques, games and situational challenges. Pre-Team - 7 years and up. Come and develop your child's swimming skills. Children must be able to swim 10 yards unassisted. Program runs from July 2nd - August 1st on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays from 3:45 - 4:45 pm. NO Rain dates. Fee: \$150.00 made payable to Town/Village of Harrison
