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**COMMITTEE REPORTS**

- **OLD ORCHARD STREET SUBDIVISION** – Old Orchard Street, Block 1011, Lot 11 – 4th 180 Day Extension

Motion to grant a 4<sup>th</sup> 180 day extension made by Kate Barnwell, seconded by Marshall Donat. Vote carried 6-0.

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1. **MASTERCARD MAIN ENTRY MODIFICATION** – 2000 Purchase Street, Block 621, Lot 2 – Site Plan Review, SEQR Review, **PUBLIC HEARING**

Peter Catizone, Engineer appeared before the Board on behalf of MasterCard regarding the modifications to the front entry.

A discussion took place about bus shelter, new lighting and screening.

3. **BRAE BURN COUNTRY CLUB – POOL SHEDS** – 39 Brae Burn Drive, Block 951, Lot 7 – Site Plan Review, SEQR Review, **PUBLIC HEARING**

Steven Vando, Brae Burn Country Club General Manager, appeared before the Board regarding the application for the pool sheds.

5. **GENTILE – SITE PLAN** – 179 Underhill Avenue, Block 824, Lot 29 – Site Plan Review, SEQR Review

Chris Crocco with Crocco Architects appeared before the Board on behalf of the application and stated that they did receive Zoning Board approval.

Motion to grant Site Plan approval made by Anthony Spano, seconded by Raymond A. Kraus. Vote carried 6-0.

6. **SCHOOL OF THE HOLY CHILD – FIELD HOUSE/STUDIO/AUDITORIUM** – 2225 Westchester Avenue, Block 601, Lots 4-4.5 – Amended Site Plan Review, Amended Special Exception Use Permit Review, Steep Slope Permit Review, SEQR Review

Kory Salomome, with Veneziano & Associates appeared before the Board on behalf of the plan along with the Architects, School Representative, Engineer and Traffic Consultant for the project.

A discussion took place regarding the height of the filed house and the construction stages. Also discussed were the current traffic flow and the proposed flow for parents and busses, storm water management and the design studio.

7. **QUITTELL-PONTICELLI RESICENCE – GUEST COTTAGE** – 8 Lincoln Lane, Block 651, Lot 21 – Site Plan Review, Special Exception Use Permit Review, SEQR Review

Robin Quittell-Ponticelli the owner appeared before the Board and went over the reasons for the cottage.

Mark Mustacato, Architect appeared before the Board and described the one story cottage being proposed.

A discussion took place regarding the location of the cottage and moving it closer to the pool. Also discussed were the finishes of the cottage to match the existing house.

A discussion took place regarding the screening of the generators. The location and the distance to the neighbors were discussed.
