The Chairman opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

- Adopt minutes from January 28, 2014

Motion to accept minutes with a minor change, Raymond A. Kraus recused himself from the Morgan Stanley application. Made by Raymond A. Kraus, seconded by Nonie Reich. Vote carried 6-0.

- **PEPSICO – PROJECT RENEW AMENDED SITE PLAN** – 700 Anderson Hill Road, Block 651, Lot 1-5, 10, 11, 25 – Amended Site Plan Review, Amended Wetland Permit Review, Amended Steep Slope Review, Amended Master Plan Review, SEQR Review, **Project Update**

Frank McCullough appeared before the Board on behalf of the applicant to give an update on the progress. He noted that the cleanup and the demo are now done. PepsiCo would like to start the visitor center within the next 2 months.

Rob Aiello with John Meyer Consulting appeared before the Board on behalf of the applicant. He gave an overview of the welcome center building.

Chris Fisher, Esq. with Cuddy & Feder appeared before the Board on behalf of the applicant.

Vince with Bloom Energy also appeared before the Board and gave an overview of the application for the fuel cell project.

Motion to grant Site Plan approval made by Marshall Donat, seconded by Kate Barnwell. Vote carried 6-0.

Motion to grant Special Exception Use Permit made by Marshall Donat, seconded by Nonie Reich. Vote carried 6-0.

2. **WESTMED – PARKING ATTENDANT BOOTH** – 210 Westchester Avenue, Block 692, Lots 1 & 2 – Site Plan Review, Wetland Permit Review, SEQR Review, **Public**

Hearing

Tony Gioffre, Esq. with Cuddy & Feder appeared before the Board on behalf of the applicant

Motion to open the Public Hearing made by Kate Barnwell, seconded by Marshall Donat. Vote carried 6-0.

Discussed were the lighting and screening concerns that some neighbors had from a previous approved project.

Tony Gioffre addressed the lighting and screening concerns of the neighbors. The lighting mitigation plan has been given to Patrick Cleary and Bob FitzSimmons. The planting was completed in conjunction with the Town Engineer in the field.

The Public Hearing was kept open until applicant has appeared before the Zoning Board of Appeals.

3. **64 BROADWAY REALTY LLC – SUBDIVISION** – 64 Broadway, Block 92, Lot 2 (2&60) – Sketch Plan Review, SEQR Review, **Public Hearing**

Mark Mustacato, Architect, appeared before the Board on behalf of the applicant. He went over the new landscape plan.

Motion to open the Public Hearing made by Anthony Spano, seconded by Raymond A. Kraus. Vote carried 6-0.

Discussed was the engineering comments regarding the closest catch basin and connecting to it.

4. **450 MAMARONCEK AVENUE – PARKING LOT EXPANSION** – 450 Mamaroneck Avenue, Block 482, Lot 23 – Site Plan Review, Steep Slopes Review, SEQR Review

Robert Weisz appeared before the Board on behalf of the application to expand the parking lot. He noted that they now have leased about 70% of the building and have a need for additional parking.

Diego Villareale with John Meyer Consulting appeared before the Board on behalf of the applicant.

Discussed was the number of spaces being proposed, lighting, retaining wall, the need for parking, decking the parking and the impervious services.

A discussion took place regarding the re-approval and what if anything has changed from the original approved subdivision.

Motion to schedule a Public Hearing for March 25, 2014 made by Nonie Reich, seconded by Marshall Donat. Vote carried 6-0.

6. **MANHATTANVILLE COLLEGE – RENOVATION OF KENNEDY GYM & EXISTING ATHLETIC FIELDS** – 2900 Purchase Street, Block 631, Lot 5 (PO 11) – Site Plan Review, Steep Slopes Review, SEQR Review

Seth Mandelbaum, Esq. with McCullough Goldberger & Staudt appeared before the Board on behalf of the applicant.

Tim Perneti, Chief Business Officer with New York City Football Club appeared before the Board and went over the use of the facility.

Jerry Schwalbe, Engineer with Divney Tung & Schwalbe reviewed the proposed renovation of the existing fields.

A discussion ensued regarding fencing, drainage, walkways, parking, grading and relocation of the soil from the grading of the tennis courts. Also discussed were the changes to the pool house.

Craig Bacheller, Architect went over the pool house conversion for the use of the team.

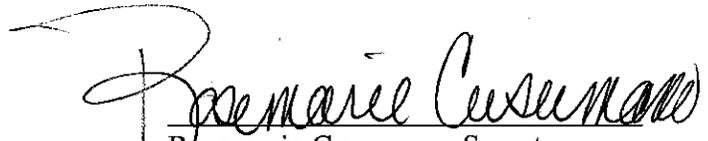
Discussed were the number of players, coaches and staff, access from college road, security, and the MLS season.

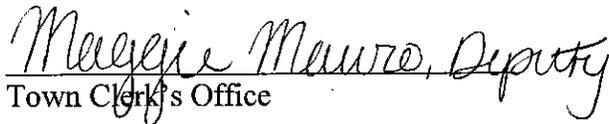
The Board will schedule a site visit before the next meeting.
