

OLD BUSINESS:

Commissioner of Public Works Anthony Robinson said he wanted to give the Board and the residents an update on automated sanitation. The truck has been ordered and we expect it by May or June. We want to put the carts that we are going to use for automated collection on display. We are going to put them on display at Sam's Gas Station in West Harrison, the Purchase Community House, the Sollazzo Center and Town Hall. At each location there will be a display board that gives a description and some photo graphics on the actual process using the truck and the cart and will show some literature of how to place the carts at the curb. It will have two separate size carts that they can view and look at. We will be sending out a letter on or about February 15th to the affected residents in the first phase of this program. We revised the routes because the initial count on one of the routes was too high in my opinion for the start of a program. We have a questionnaire that is going out to the affected residents along with a descriptive letter. We will be asking some questions about their placement of garbage out on the curb now on a volume basis and we will ask them their preference on cart size.

Harrison resident Elizabeth Pritchard said she was upset by this Board's reaction to Rob Porto. If you had mirrors in front of you to see the expressions on your faces and the comments that you were making it is embarrassing to me as a resident and I'm annoyed that you would act that way. I think you should all take stock of your behavior at these Board meetings. This is not the way professionals behave.

Mayor Belmont thanked her for her comments.


