Re: Time Limit Parking

Mayor Belmont and Members of the Village Board:

I respectfully request a Village Board resolution to establish 2 hour parking from 9 am – 6 pm except Saturday, Sunday, and Holidays on Holland Street from Nelson Avenue to Ellsworth Avenue (both sides of the street) and Batavia Place from Calvert Street to Webster Avenue (both sides of the street).

After researching the Village Vehicle and Traffic Ordinances, we found no parking restrictions listed for this section of Holland Street and Batavia Place. Time limit parking applies only to the section of Holland Street from Landolfe Place to Nelson Avenue (both sides of the street) which is currently 2 hour parking 9 am – 6 pm except Saturday, Sunday, and Holidays.

There have been complaints about commuter and business employees parking there throughout the day. I respectfully request your consideration to these proposed changes.
