Re: Forest Lake & Dawson Ct.

Dear Supervisor Belmont and Members of the Town Board:

I respectfully request a Village board resolution to amend section 38-47 of the vehicle and traffic section of the Village of Harrison for the stop signs at the following intersections:

- Forest Lake and Park Lane, Forest Lake and Stonewall Cr. and Dawson Ct. and Forest Lake Dr.

The stop signs were installed by the developer prior to Forest Lake Dr and Dawson Ct. becoming dedicated roads by the Town/Village of Harrison. In addition, I respectfully request to modify the no parking restrictions on Forest Lake Dr. and Dawson Ct. My recommendation is that section 38-52 of the V.T.O. be amended

From: No Parking on both sides of Forest Lake Dr .

To: No Parking on the North side of Forest Lake Dr. from Stonewall Cr. to Park La. and to remove the No Parking restrictions on both sides of Dawson Ct.

Forest Lake Dr. is wide enough to accommodate two-way traffic even with vehicles parked on one side. The roadway is lightly traveled by area residents who, for the most part, park in their driveways and garages.

Dawson Ct. is a cul-de-sac with very light traffic which consists primarily of home owners who park in their driveways and garages. At this time parking restrictions are not needed on this roadway. It is on a rare occasion vehicle will be found parked on either one of the aforementioned roads.

Furthermore, the number of signs installed by the developer on Forest Lake Dr. is inadequate and unenforceable. Dawson Ct. has never had any No Parking signs installed which also made this restriction unenforceable.

The current parking restrictions are an inconvenience to the residents of this development. It leaves no street parking for residents, their guests or people performing work at their homes.
