Re: Forest Lake Drive & Dawson Court

Dear Supervisor Belmont and Members of the Town Board:

I respectfully request a Village board resolution to amend Section 38-47 of the Vehicle and Traffic Section of the Village of Harrison for the stop signs at the following intersections:  
Forest Lake Drive and Park Lane, Forest Lake Drive and  
Stonewall Circle and Dawson Court and Forest Lake Drive

The stop signs were installed by the developer prior to Forest Lake Drive and Dawson Court becoming dedicated roads by the Town/Village of Harrison.

In addition, I respectfully request to modify the No Parking restrictions on Forest Lake Drive and Dawson Court. The current parking restrictions are an inconvenience to the residents of this development. It leaves no street parking for the residents, their guests or people performing work on their homes.

My recommendation is that Section 38-52 of the V.T.O. be amended from No Parking on both sides of Forest Lake Drive and Dawson Court to No Parking on the south side of Forest Lake Drive from Stonewall Circle to Park Lane and No Parking on the north side of Dawson Court from Forest Lake Drive to the dead end.

Forest Lake Drive and Dawson Court are wide enough to accommodate two-way traffic, even with vehicles parked on one side. The roadway is lightly traveled by area residents, who for the most part, park in their driveways and garages.

Furthermore, the amount of distance between the No Parking signs, which were installed by the developer on Forest Lake Drive, make this ordinance difficult to enforce. No Parking signs were never installed on Dawson Court which made this restriction unenforceable. There have never been any traffic issues to the present date in this development. I find no reason why parking should not be permitted on one side of the roadway at the aforementioned locations.


