Dear Mayor Belmont and Members of the Town Board:


Our firm currently represents Heritage Realty Services, LLC and LifeTime Fitness, Inc., the owners of all property fronting on and having access from Gannett Drive.

LifeTime Fitness is the successor owner to Gannett Satellite Information Service who sold its property to LifeTime Fitness, Inc. earlier this year. The Gannett buildings have since been demolished and construction on the new LifeTime Fitness facility has begun. Gannett has moved its offices to White Plains and moved its printing and distribution facilities out of New York State.

Both Heritage Realty and LifeTime Fitness feel it is now appropriate to rename Gannett Drive to a more generic and less user specific name and would suggest that the new name of the street be Westchester Park Drive. Heritage is in the final stages of developing a plan to repositioning of the office park and would like the change of name to take place at the earliest possible date. LifeTime Fitness is also anxious to have the name change take place prior to the commencement of marketing efforts for its new facility.
