2013 - - 018 OLD BUSINESS

Supervisor Belmont addressed the audience and applauded them for coming to the meeting. The Supervisor said there is not anything more important then our children's safety. We said that we would have police officers in our schools through at least January 5th and we would meet tonight, as a Board, after tonight's meeting, to either increase the police presence or take it away. Prior to tonight's meeting we had not made a decision to take it away or add to the presence. We were planning to meet as a Board and with the Chief of Police after tonight's meeting. We are going to keep the police presence at our schools for a while longer. The Board of Education has not met yet to let us know if they would like us to stay and be present at the schools or cut back. We want to work together with them for our children's safety.

Police Chief Marraccini addressed the Board and audience by thanking everyone for being at the meeting to show support for our entire community. He explained his personal appreciation and that of his department. This event (the shooting in Newtown CT) has consumed my staff and myself since the last meeting in trying to figure out solutions for having security for our children. It is a huge task and there are so many components to this it can't be settled here tonight. Having police officers in the school is going to give everybody a great sense of security. There are many components to it; training issues and building security, which I believe is where it should start. We need to make sure our buildings are secure and we are going to be working with the school district to try and help them facilitate a plan to do that. We need to have a very well thought out plan that not only provides for our kid's security but as a community we need to keep our residents secure and keep crime down. These are problems faced by many municipalities with budget restrictions. This Board is taking us in the right direction with manpower by adding staffing. The Board has approved for me to keep police officers in the schools and it costs money but they made the decision that we are going to make that expenditure. It is a start but not an end all solution. One of the most important keys to this solution is the Student Resource Officer (SRO) program in the middle and high schools. We are moving forward, looking at solutions, meeting with the Superintendent of Schools. My staff and the Superintendent's staff will start as early as tomorrow to evaluate the buildings. I would be happy to answer any questions.

Police Chief Marraccini responded to residents in the audience. He confirmed that the Board has authorized him to continue staffing the police officers in the schools. As we progress and work with the school district to address potential building security problems and formulate a plan then I will come back to the Board with some solutions. The plan or the solution can't be done overnight. Police Officers in the schools tomorrow is not the solution.

Police Chief Marraccini responded to a resident's question for the possibility of outsourcing to a private security firm. The Chief went on to say that these are school buildings and we are going to give the School Board our suggestions. If they want to engage professionals to get further insight I would encourage them to do so. Our police officers are evaluating some security concerns and whether or not the school can fund the costs in an unknown factor.

Police Chief Marraccini responded to the question asking if the SRO program would be in the elementary schools. The Chief said there was never a plan to have this program in the elementary schools. As we examine this program, if we decide to insert police officers into every school, it would develop into that. I can't tell you right now that I am going to put police officers, everyday, in every school, forever. This is a huge undertaking and if it is not done correctly you are not guaranteeing anyone's safety. I don't have the solution yet, but I will. I have some plans that I would like to put into effect, in the very near future that will help, absolutely. Establishing the SRO's in the middle and high schools is all part of this plan.

Police Chief Marraccini answered a resident's question on whether the Board would guarantee that police officers would be in the schools through the month of June. The Chief responded by saying that this matter needs to be further discussed and the community will be kept informed. The last thing he wanted was for anyone to leave with a false sense of security. There is a reality here. A police officer in every school is not the solution to this problem.

Police Chief Marraccini responded to the question from a resident asking if it was possible to reallocate current resources to provide better protection to the children. The Chief stated: We provide public safety on a daily basis and with the staffing levels some days it is even inadequate to do that. We are in the process of rebuilding the department. We are looking at the alternative of civilian dispatchers so it will give us some immediate relief where we could pull some officers out of patrol to do these specialized details.

Police Chief Marraccini was told by a resident that she wanted to leave the meeting knowing that she can feel good when she drops her child off at school and wanted to be assured that the police officers would be in the schools until the end of June.

Councilwoman Amelio said that there is an important ingredient that is missing here and that is the involvement of the school. Until we get that organization moving we can't tell you anything. We haven't met with the School Board and that is a really important issue here.

Supervisor Belmont said that he has met with the Superintendent of Schools. He noted that the school board has not met since after the Newtown CT incident happened. He said that he cannot control the school board but they were having a regular meeting on January 9th at 8:15 pm at Louis M. Klein Middle School.

Councilwoman Ameilo said that all the residents here tonight need to understand that, as important as your presence is here tonight, it is equally important to be at the next school board meeting.

Police Chief Marraccini explained to the audience that his department will make security recommendations but it is up to the school to make security improvements to their buildings. The Town Board has been very accommodating and has been working with the Superintendent to get a plan instituted. The Town Board has already extended the police officers being in the schools so there are a lot of things that have happened since our last meeting.

Police Chief Marraccini and the Town Board were asked by a resident to attend the school board meeting so all parties can work together and to keep residents informed on what is going on. Chief Marraccini responded that he did not have plans to be at the school board meeting but if asked, he would attend. It is not normal for a police chief to go to a school board meeting but I'd be happy to go there and answer any questions.

Supervisor Belmont said to the audience when asked why, before tonight, were they going to stop having police officers in the school on January 4th and he replied that his statement was we were going to reevaluate it after tonight's meeting.

Police Chief Marraccini said he had the approval to staff, with overtime, through tomorrow. But the board has decided to continue it.

Councilman Malfitano addressed the audience by reminding them that the way we left this at the last meeting was that we would re-evaluate this situation this evening after the meeting. In my mind, based on last meeting discussions, there wasn't anyone here that made a decision to discontinue. It was our intension to have a report made to us this evening, to have some discussion on how we were progressing, so we could evaluate how we are going to continue to work on this moving forward. I think it is unfortunate that somewhere information was made to the community that police officers were being pulled from the schools and we never made that decision.

Supervisor Belmont said that his door and phone are always opened and to please feel free to give him a call.
