Notification by Comptroller Maureen MacKenzie that Municipalities in New York State are <u>now</u> allowed to purchase items and to contract for service's through the use of contracts let by the United States or any agency thereof, any state or any other political subdivision or district therein. In the past, we were only allowed to purchase off of a NYS contract. If there was no NYS contract and the amount of the purchase or service contract exceeded our purchasing threshold, we would have to go out to bid, which is both costly and time consuming.

Comptroller MacKenzie said that municipalities have been waiting for a long time for this change in the law. They are calling this "piggybacking". If another municipality or community does a bid, it would have to conform to New York State Law, and then we would be able to "piggyback" on that bid. It would be checked to make sure it conforms to the New York State bid process; the law department would review it. We would still go to the Board for approval of the purchase order.
