Village Attorney Kraut said that it is but if you would like to put this item off until after Executive Session I have copies for the Board and can answer any questions that the Board may have. Councilman Cannella requested this be taken into executive session.

Councilwoman Amelio asked Village Attorney Kraut to explain to the audience what a pilot program is.

Village Attorney Kraut explained that a Pilot Agreement is an agreement for payment in lieu of taxes. There is creative financing that is stimulated by the Westchester Industrial. Development Agency. This establishes a transaction to save the property developer sales tax on a variety of improvements that they are going to do or have done to the property. Lifetime Fitness is a new corporate presence in the town. They have put a tremendous amount of work and effort into developing a beautiful site. It is going to be a nice amenity to the community and this payment in lieu of taxes agreement will allow them to continue to pay taxes to us in the form of a pilot payment because when you do the financing through the IDA the property actually gets classified as a tax exempt parcel. This is just a way to structure the transaction so that they continue to pay the proper tax amount for their property.

Councilman Cannella said for the purpose of understanding it also gives the town the advantage of actually being able to estimate with absoluteness the amount of the tax assessment with respect to the facility for the period that is covered by the pilot rather then to have it potentially be subject to debate and contest.

Village Attorney Kraut said to Councilman Canella's points specifically they waive their right to grieve or challenge taxes, which many corporate tenants are looking to save money have done that, so this prevents that happening for ten years.
