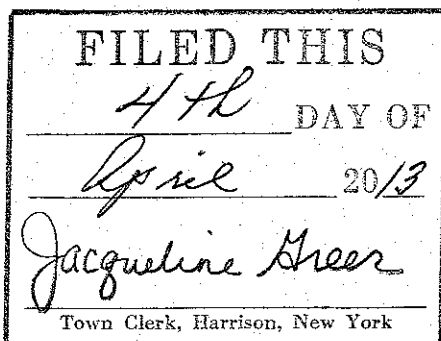

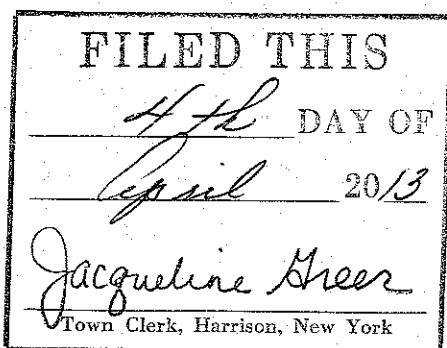

PRESENTATION BY JAMES MURABITO

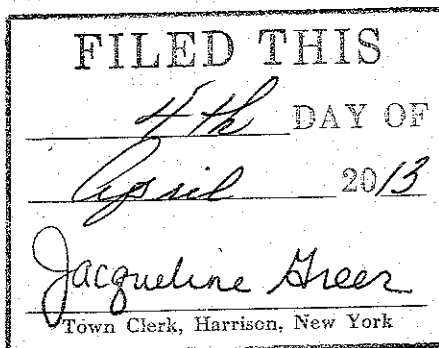
RE: SKATE PARK

Supervisor Belmont asked Mr. Baker if he was familiar with the history and what the Board has done so far on this subject.

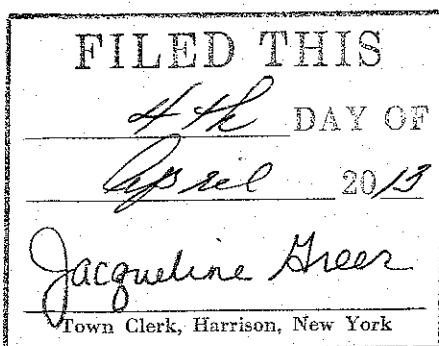

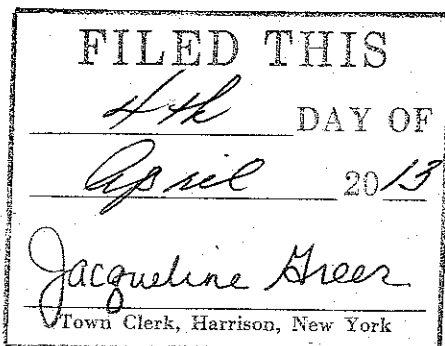

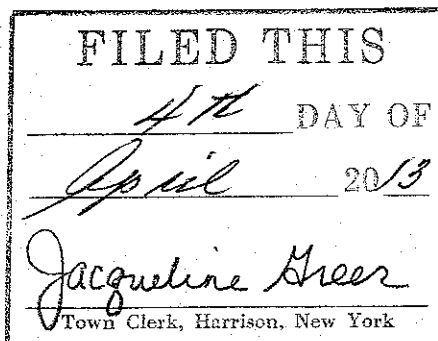
