AUTHORIZATION FOR CHANGE ORDER #1 AND CHANGE ORDER #2 TO THE CONTRACT WITH COPPOLA PAVING AND LANDSCAPING CORP., RE: INSTALLATION OF A CONCRETE PAD AT THE RECYCLING CENTER GLEASON PLACE GARAGE

Anthony Robinson, Commissioner of Public Works explained why there was an increase from the original amount. He said the original contract was to create a concrete roadway in the recycling area at the Gleason garage. Over time, the containers that we used to truck out the recyclable materials had to be dragged out of the area. Over time it rutted the soft ground underneath. This made the sub-base unstable. In order to alleviate the condition a new concrete roadway had to be designed so there wouldn't be the same rutting.

On motion of Trustee Cannella, seconded by Trustee Amelio,

it was

RESOLVED to approve the request of Commissioner of Public Works Anthony Robinson for authorization for Change Order #1 in the amount of \$23,840 and Change Order #2 in the amount of \$26,500 to the contract with Coppola Paving and Landscaping Corporation.

Change Order #1 – During the performance of concrete work it was noted that there were several additional locations that were badly deteriorated. This necessitated the placement of an additional 1,490 square feet of concrete. Change Order #1 provides additional compensation in the amount of \$23,840 to the contractor to furnish all labor, materials and equipment necessary for the placement of additional concrete.

Change Order #2 - A 6,610 square foot area of existing asphalt at the south end of the facility is badly deteriorated and requires replacement. Change Order #2 provides additional compensation to the contractor in the amount of \$26,500 to furnish all labor, materials and equipment to place NYSDOT Type 3 HD Binder Asphalt in the affected area.

FURTHER RESOLVED that the Law Department is authorized to increase the upset limit for this contract from \$67,400 to a revised contract amount of \$117,740.

FURTHER RESOLVED that funding is available in Capital Accounts 13HW09 and 13HW11.

FURTHER RESOLVED to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Law Department, the Treasurer, the Commissioner of Public Works and the Purchasing Department.
