- C. PUBLIC HEARING:
1. PUBLIC HEARING – Pursuant to Article 2, Section 10 and Article 3, Section 20 of the Municipal Home Rule Law, amending Chapter 155 of the Town/Village Code entitled “Garbage, Rubbish and Refuse” by Local Law of 2011, amending Section 155-1 B. (4) and (5) of the Town/Village Code of the Town/Village of Harrison entitled “Placement for collection; collection in commercial districts.

- E. ACTIONS AND RESOLUTIONS:
1. Notification by William Fraser and Kevin Dellner, of the Halstead Manor Centennial Committee for the Halstead Manor Firehouse, 1400 Halstead Avenue, Mamaroneck, that the Halstead Manor & Hose Company #4 is celebrating its 100th Anniversary, Sunday, June 12, 2011. A Block Party will be held at the Halstead Manor Firehouse, 1400 Halstead Avenue, Mamaroneck, from 2 to 6 pm. **Request** that parking be reserved on both sides of Halstead Avenue, in the vicinity of Food City, to accommodate for fire apparatus.

2a. Request authorizing Infrastructure Improvements in connection with the Old Orchard Street Subdivision at a cost of \$1,500,000.

2b. Request by Purchasing Clerk Marie Bailey for approval of a Bid Award to ELQ Industries, 567 Fifth Avenue, New Rochelle, NY, 10801, having met all the requirements of the specifications for the Infrastructure Development for the Old Orchard Street Subdivision, at their total net bid price of \$1,182,945. **Further** that funding is available within the Bond Resolution previously adopted this evening. **Further** requested to authorize the Law Department to prepare the contract, and the Mayor to execute the same.

3. Request by Chief of Police Anthony Marraccini for an amendment to the following parking regulation in the Village Ordinances:

Section 38-55: Designate a Loading zone on the east side of Underhill Avenue beginning at the intersection of Beechwood Avenue and continue 50 feet north from the hours of 7:30 am to 4:00 pm Monday – Friday except holidays.

4. Request by the Chief that a resolution be passed to prohibit parking on the south side of the street on Osborn Road from the Rye City line to Halstead Avenue. After evaluating the area the Chief recommends that parking be allowed on the north side of the street only.

5. Request by the Chief for an amendment to the following parking regulation in the Village Ordinances:

Section 38-53/ - 38-54/38-55: No Stopping Standing Parking on the south side of Beechwood Avenue between Underhill Avenue and Oak Street. This area is currently no parking anytime on the south side of Beechwood Avenue.

6. Request by the Chief for a revision to section 38-55 of the Village Vehicle & Traffic regulations regarding the area of 141 and 143 Lake Street. The regulation manual currently reads “No Parking from 8:00 am to 6:00 pm” from utility pole #42, 200 feet east to utility pole #44. The proposed change would read “No Stopping, Standing or Parking” in the area of 141 and 143 Lake Street from utility pole #42, 200 feet north to utility pole #44. The proposed change is necessary to maintain a line of sight for motorists exiting Sam’s Service Station.

7. Request by the Chief for State Legislation to amend Article 41, Section 1662-c of the New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law, authorizing residential parking permits in West Harrison.
