Harrison Food Pantry

Monthly Food Distribution on March 7, 2024, our team served:

- 113 Children
- 225 Adults
- 40 Senior citizens
- 131 Households

New Registrations - 6 new families registered - referred by HCSD.

<u>Food Drives</u>—Each of the 4 elementary schools held 4 community food drives benefitting HFP for "Souperbowl."

Clothing - we secured clothing from the Sharing Shelf for 12 children in need

Community notes:

-Youth Service Awards @St. Vincent's - Harrison resident, Manny Homem, was the Keynote speaker and Faria Ahmed from HHS was a Youth Award recipient.

Harrison Market is scheduled to close on March 31. This will directly impact the food pantry, as HM is the only affordable market in town and is within walking distance for seniors living in the nearby apartment buildings. We will see an increase in food pantry registrations and the need for assistance. Further, the market employs Harrison residents.
