Enacting Chapter 63, entitled "Term Limits" of the Town Code of the Town of Harrison

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Town Board of the Town of Harrison, at its meeting to be held at 7:00 P.M., on August 18, 2022, at the Municipal Building, 1 Heineman Place, Harrison, New York, will hold a Public Hearing pursuant to Article 2, Section 10 and Article 3, Section 20 of the Municipal Home Rule Law, by enacting a new Chapter 63, entitled, "Term Limits" of the Town Code of the Town of Harrison as follows: (new material is <u>underlined</u> and deletions are in brackets []).

- 1. Except as provided in this Section, no person shall be eligible to be elected, appointed or otherwise hold the office of Supervisor if that person has previously held such office for a total of five (5) terms, a maximum of ten (10) years.
- 2. No person shall be eligible to be elected, appointed or otherwise hold office of Councilperson if that person had previously held such office for a total of five (5) terms, a maximum of twenty (20) years.
- 3. If a Supervisor or Councilperson resigns, vacates or is removed from office prior to completion of a full term, he or she shall be deemed to have held that office for the full term for the purposes of this Section of the Town Code.

This Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of the State of New York.
