

To Whom It May Concern at the Town of Harrison, NY,

Please accept this letter as an addendum for the Special Event Permit Application regarding our fundraising walk to be held this year on June 3, 2023 on the grounds of Manhattanville College. Walk to Defeat ALS is the walk program for the ALS Association.

We have arranged with the staff at Manhattanville College to hold the event at Damman Field on-campus. It's a basic charity walk. We will have about 700 people park on-site, gather in an open field, listen to some music, eat wrapped breakfast items, they'll walk on a route contained within the campus borders, return to the field, and leave. Same day pop-up tent and table set-up. The walkers arrive around 9:30, the walks starts at 11:00, and the event usually ends around 12:30 with event breakdown to immediately follow. We have our own 10' x 10' pop-up tents. The walk is rain or shine. We bring fire extinguishers to all events. We have also called the Harrison First Aid squad, who will have an ambulance stationed on-site.

The ALS Association has an umbrella insurance policy and we will be providing copies to the Town and to Manhattanville College to name them both as additionally insured.
