

Special Event Indemnification, Release and Discharge Agreement

American Cancer Society , (hereinaster "Indemnitor") agrees to protect, defend, indemnify and hold the Town of Harrison and the Village of Harrison, their officers, agents and employees free and harmless from and against any and all losses, penalties, damages, settlements, costs, charges, professional fees, or other expenses or liabilities of every kind and character arising out of or relating to any and all claims, liens, demands, obligations, actions, proceedings or causes of action of every kind of character in connection with or arising, directly or indirectly, out of the Indemnitor or any participant at any event held or sponsored by the Indemnitor's use of the Town of Harrison's right-of-ways, roads, sidewalks, property, or facilities of any kind. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, all such claims, etc., relating to personal injury, death, damage to property, defects in material, workmanship, actual or alleged infringement on any other tangible of intangible personal property or property right, or any alleged violation of any applicable statute, ordinance, administrative order, rule or regulation, or decree of any court shall be included in the indemnity hereunder.

The Indemnitor, further agrees to investigate, handle, respond to, provide defense for and defend any such claims, etc., at its sole expense and agrees to bear all other costs and expenses related thereto, even if it (claims, etc.) is groundless, false or fraudulent. In any case in which such indemnification would violate Section 5-322.1 of the New York General Obligations Law, or any other applicable legal prohibition, the foregoing provisions concerning indemnification shall not be construed to indemnify the owner for damage arising out of bodily injury to persons or damage to property caused by or resulting from the sole negligence of the owner or its employees.

















Making Strides Against Breast Cancer of Westchester Parking Map
