At the last meeting, Harrison resident and retired Harrison Police Detective, Louis Arlotta, came before the board to discuss his plan for The Walt Mallinson 9/11 Memorial to be erected in Ma Riis Park.

The Memorial will recognize all Harrison 9/11 Ground Zero First Responders, predominately Police Officer Walter Mallinson who passed away from 9/11 Cancer.

The Memorial will be funded by donations and Lou has requested that donations be sent to the Town of Harrison and kept in a separate account titled 9/11 Memorial Ma Riis Park. The account will be under the control of Town Comptroller Maureen MacKenzie. Any and all withdrawals from this account will come at the request of Louis Arlotta and will be used solely for the purpose of the erection of the Memorial. The account will be closed upon the completion of the Memorial and any remaining funds within it will be donated to a 9/11 Charity.

Lou respectfully requests that the board authorize the building of the Memorial in Ma Riis Park within the vicinity of the War Memorial and that the cost of the Memorial be funded by donations.

I respectfully request that I as Comptroller, be authorized to establish an account within the Trust and Agency Fund titled 9/11 Memorial Ma Riis Park.
