APPLICATION FOR 3040 WESTCHESTER AVENUE

On motion of Councilwoman Amelio, seconded by Councilman Sciliano, the hearing was opened.

Mr. Seth Mandelbaum representing the law of firm McCullough, Goldberger & Staudt attended the meeting on behalf of the applicant Westchester Avenue Associates. Mr. Mandelbaum discussed a proposed office building at 3040 Westchester Avenue. This application presented tonight is for a new office building and a new two level parking garage on the site. This has gone through extensive review before every board of the town and given a negative declaration under SEQRA by the Planning Board on June 28, 2016. This Board adopted some amendments to the parking dimensions for the town back in July that applied to this site and many other sites in town. A few variances were granted by the Zoning Board on September 8, 2016 and finally on September 27, 2016 the Planning Board granted a Special Exception Use Permit subject to final Special Exception Use Permit approval from this Board.

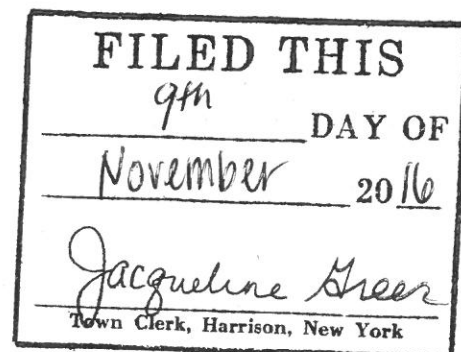

Councilwoman Amelio asked Mr. Mandelbaum if this is going to be a better screening process then what occurred on Anderson Hill Road where the parking lot is.

Mr. Mandelbaum responded yes, particularly since the parking deck is proposed on the far west side and backs up to the 2900 building where there are no residents, it is all commercial.

Supervisor Belmont asked if anyone wanted to speak on the Public Hearing tonight.
