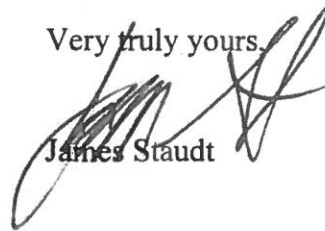
This firm represents Trinity Presbyterian Church (the "Applicant"), the owner of the above referenced property (the "Property"). As you will recall, on January 26, 2017, this Board granted Final Special Exception Use approval for the Applicant to establish a church use on the Property. Subsequently, the Board granted two (2) ninety (90) day extensions of that approval.

Pursuant to Section 235-14(J) of the Harrison Zoning Ordinance, a Building Permit must be applied for within ninety (90) days of the Final Special Exception Use Permit approval. The Applicant is working with their contractors to finalize construction drawings for filing with the Building Department.

Although the drawings are near completion, it does not appear they will be completed in time for a Building Permit application to be filed by the October 26, 2017 deadline. We therefore respectfully request a third ninety (90) day extension, until January 26, 2017, of the Applicant's time to file for a Building Permit.
