Angelo Delborgo. His retirement will be effective May 9, 2022.

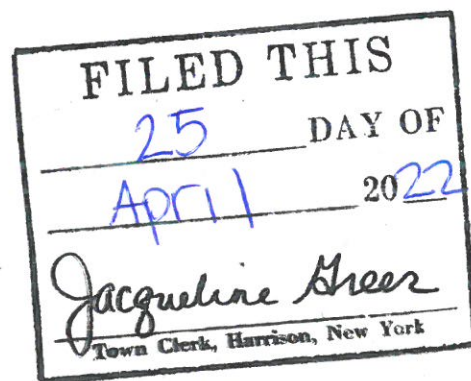

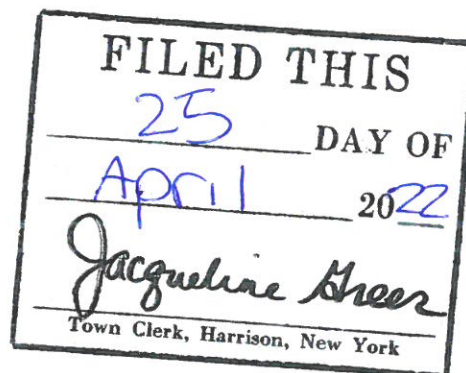
