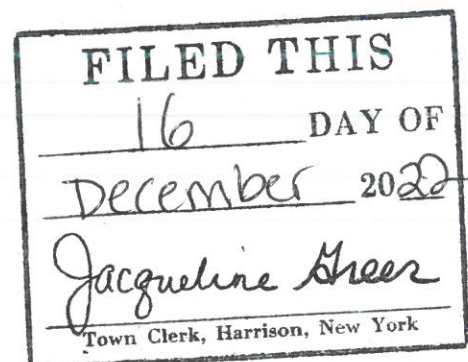

SUSTAINABLE WESTCHESTER AS IT RELATES TO OUR SANITATION AND  
RECYCLING COMMUNICATIONS PLATFORM

RESOLVED to accept the request by, Department of Public Works General Foreman, Christopher Park, for the Mayor to execute the agreement with Sustainable Westchester as it relates to our sanitation and recycling communications platform. This agreement extends our relationship with Sustainable Westchester (SW). Sustainable Westchester created the Recycle Right App used by the Village of Harrison and surrounding communities. SW provides all maintenance on the app. The estimated annual cost to the Village is \$5,500. This is a budgeted item. It is also expected that a grant from NYSDEC shall cover half the cost in subsequent years. The Law Department has reviewed the agreement and deems it satisfactory for execution.

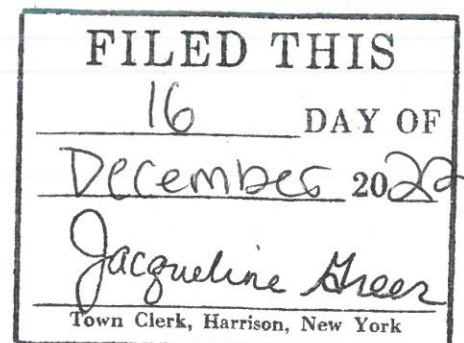
