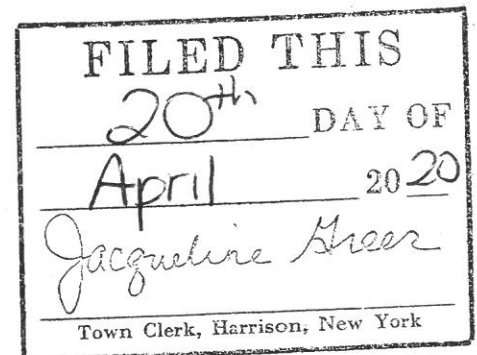

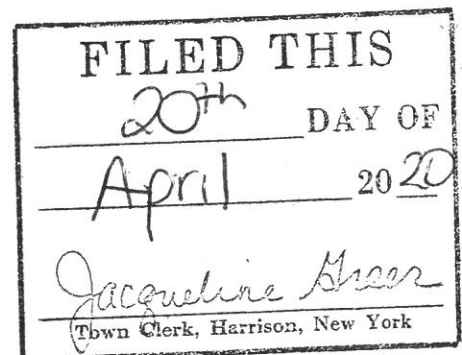
FURTHER RESOLVED to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Chief of Police and the Law Department.

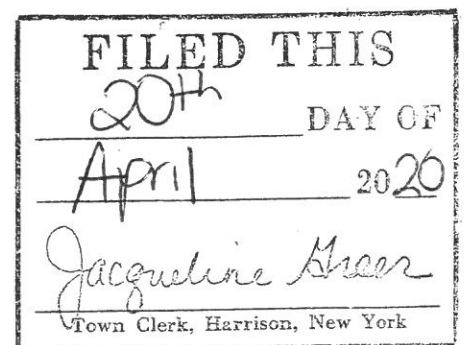

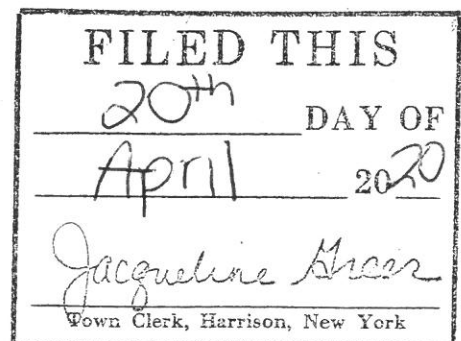
