

Policy Information

Refund Policy:

- There will be a \$15.00 processing fee for the withdrawal from any program regardless of reason.
- Partial refunds may be granted if spot can be filled from waiting list.
- Refunds will not be granted after the start of the first session/game.
- Full refunds will be issued for any program cancelled by the Recreation Department.

Placement Information:

Players will be notified by coach about team placement and first practice as well as the start of the season. Please refrain from calling the Recreation Department until the Coach is given ample time to call all players.

Players moving up to new age groupings will not be moved with former teammates as a group and will be re-distributed. Please refrain from making special request for team placement. (Excludes K-2nd grades)

Parental Rules of Conduct:

- Parents must be encouraging & supportive in regards to all children
- Parents must respect the decisions made by sports officials
- Parents should show good sportsmanship so their children may learn by example.

Harrison Youth Leagues Draft Process

We will be standardizing all Harrison youth league draft process in the 2017 season. Youth leagues include Little League, Babe Ruth, Soccer, Football, Basketball and Lacrosse. Once your child has been selected and placed on a team, he or she will remain on that team and NO REFUNDS.

Each youth league will be responsible to select coaches for each team.

K thru 2nd Grade Draft Process:

At this level we allow 2 coaches at the draft per team. We are flexible about selecting children from same area of town or schools. We try our best to put 3 kids per team from same area of town or school for car pool purpose.

3rd thru 6th Grade Draft Process:

At this level ONLY 1 coach per team at Draft (EXCEPT Football - 2 coaches are allowed). No flexibility you can only select players from those who are put up on the board to be selected. Goal is to create teams that are more evenly matched and to meet children from all areas of town.

7th thru High School Draft Process:

At this level only 1 coach per team (Exception: High School Basketball league has no coaches and players pick their own teams)

South East Consortium for Special Services

The Harrison Recreation Department is a member of the SEC for Special Services, Inc., a non-profit organization that provides year 'round therapeutic Recreation programs for children & adults with disabilities. South East offers a variety of programs & activities designed to develop physical, social, cognitive & emotional skills. These programs & services are open to all residents in the member communities. Tuesday exercise classes from 10:45 am to 11:30 am. Mah Jongg Group meets Monday, Wednesday, and Friday every week @ 11:00 am. Knitting Group meets every Tuesday @ 10:00 am. There is also a Baking Group that meets various times.

The Downtown Group meets every Friday from 12:00 noon through 2:00 pm at the Veterans Memorial Building, 210 Halstead Avenue. We also have a drop-in center at the Harrison Community Center, 216 Halstead Avenue, available Monday through Friday from 10:00 am to 4:00 pm where you may enjoy television, cards and socializing. Tuesday exercise classes from 9:30 am to 10:15 am. Mah Jongg Group meets Monday and Tuesday @ 10:00 & 1:00 pm. The Canasta Group meets every Thursday @ 12:30 pm.

We serve 2 hot lunches per week Monday & Tuesday at 12pm for both centers, sandwich lunch Thursday in West Harrison. The cost is \$5.00 per lunch, hot or cold. Must sign up and pay the week before.

Both groups participate in many activities including luncheons, day trips, overnight trips, special event dates, exercise, yoga and holiday celebrations, just to name a few. All Seniors are very welcomed to join the nearest center and to participate in all its activities.

We also assist youngsters in resume writing, interviewing skills, and job readiness, and then match them to available jobs with area residents and businesses as part of our Youth Employment Service..


