1. Request by Purchasing Department to issue Purchase Order #410290 to Vance Country Ford for the purchase of a 2021 Ford Interceptor Hybrid Utility vehicle at a cost of \$39,270.13. The vehicle will be purchased through Rockland County contract RFB-RC-2019-072. Funding is available is Capital Account 19PO14, Account # 006-3120-200-9875.
2. A. Request by Purchasing Department to issue Purchase Order #410300 to John Vance Motors, Inc. for the purchase of a 2020 Dodge Charger AWD at a cost of \$28,163.81.
