Vehicle and Traffic Waiver & Plea Agreement

The defendant understands that he/she has the right to be represented by an attorney, but wishes to proceed without the assistance of an attorney and hereby waive that right. Furthermore, a plea of guilty to certain Vehicle and Traffic offenses may be subject to the imposition of "points" in accordance with the New York State Department of Motor Vehicles Driver Violation Point System and may further subject the defendant to financial sanctions from DMV as well as insurance ramifications. These ramifications apply to all motorists, regardless of the State that issues one's license to operate a motor vehicle. The defendant has read and understands the warnings that appear on the Uniform Traffic Ticket(s) issued.

The defendant understands that he/she has a right to a trial on these charges and hereby waives that right and wishes to enter a plea of guilty as set forth below. The defendant understands that he/she has the right to appeal the decision of this court within thirty (30) days.

The defendant understands that any plea of guilty to a third (3rd) speeding offense within the last eighteen (18) months may result in a suspension of the defendant's privilege to operate a motor vehicle in the State of New York as set forth by the Department of Motor Vehicles.
