Dear Ms. Greer:

Allow me to introduce our organization to you. We are a Harrison based motorcycle club comprised mostly of police officers, firemen and emergency medical personnel. Our focus is on assisting charities, particularly in our community. We participate in many Harrison functions such as "Great to Live in Harrison Day" and are regular contributors to the Harrison PBA, Harrison Food Bank, etc.

This year we are sponsoring a motorcycle ride to benefit Taylor Madison Mangieri, a 3 year old with cystic fibrosis. Taylor and her family struggle with the costs of treatment, housing and daily living expenses. Taylor's mother is a single mom who only receives limited support from Taylor's father.

The ride will culminate in a barbeque at OFF THE GRID 73 Crotona Ave. Harrison, NY 10528. The barbeque will take place from 1 p.m. until 4 p.m. on Sunday June 1, 2014. One aspect of the ride/barbeque will be a "Bike Show" judged by an editor of American Iron Magazine. The winner of the bike show will receive a photo spread in American Iron.

We propose to close off Crotona Avenue from Post Place to Webster Avenue for the purpose of safely parking the motorcycles involved in the event and conducting the bike show. Members of Shield & Cross M.C. will direct parking along Crotona Avenue. We feel that such closure will insure the safety of pedestrians and patrons attending the event.

Members of our organization will contact neighbors door to door in the weeks before the event and we will offer to valet cars so as not to inconvenience our neighbors. I should add that the ride will be police escorted to maintain safety and order.
