Proposed Local Law __ of 2016

**A LOCAL LAW TO REVISE THE ZONING ORDINANCE
OF THE TOWN OF HARRISON AND VILLAGE OF HARRISON
BY AMENDING CHAPTER 220 ENTITLED “TREES”**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Town Board, at its meeting to be held at 7:30 P.M., on Thursday, September 15, 2016, at the Municipal Building, 1 Heineman Place, Harrison, New York, will hold a Public Hearing pursuant to Article 2, Section 10 and Article 3, Section 20 of the Municipal Home Rule Law, to amend Chapter 220, Section 220-6 entitled “Replacement of Trees”, by Local Law No. __ of 2016, of the Code of the Town/Village of Harrison shall be amended as follows: (new material is underlined. Deletions are in [brackets].

Section 220-6. Replacement of Trees

[Where a building permit is required and more than three trees are to be removed,] When a tree is to be removed, the owner of the property shall submit plans showing removal of trees and replacement. In areas where trees are to be removed or destroyed, all existing trees specifying types and sizes shall be shown, and the reasons for removing or destroying any trees in such manner shall be set forth. The plans shall provide for one new tree[s] to be planted [in sufficient quantity] for each tree removed, taking into account the anticipated survival rate, to replace the destroyed trees in kind or in suitable alternate species, at the discretion of the Town Tree Committee. Where the existing trees

are too large to be replaced with trees of equivalent size, the planting of [multiple] trees of suitable species may be substituted.

This local law shall take effect upon filing with the Secretary of State.
