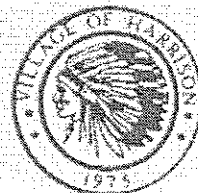

Special Event Indemnification, Release and Discharge Agreement

Church of St. Anthony (hereinafter "Indemnitor") agrees to protect, defend, indemnify and hold the Town of Harrison and the Village of Harrison, their officers, agents and employees free and harmless from and against any and all losses, penalties, damages, settlements, costs, charges, professional fees, or other expenses or liabilities of every kind and character arising out of or relating to any and all claims, liens, demands, obligations, actions, proceedings or causes of action of every kind of character in connection with or arising, directly or indirectly, out of the Indemnitor or any participant at any event held or sponsored by the Indemnitor's use of the Town of Harrison's right-of-ways, roads, sidewalks, property, or facilities of any kind. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, all such claims, etc., relating to personal injury, death, damage to property, defects in material, workmanship, actual or alleged infringement on any other tangible or intangible personal property or property right, or any alleged violation of any applicable statute, ordinance, administrative order, rule or regulation, or decree of any court shall be included in the indemnity hereunder.

The Indemnitor, further agrees to investigate, handle, respond to, provide defense for and defend any such claims, etc., at its sole expense and agrees to bear all other costs and expenses related thereto, even if it (claims, etc.) is groundless, false or fraudulent. In any case in which such indemnification would violate Section 5-322.1 of the New York General Obligations Law, or any other applicable legal prohibition, the foregoing provisions concerning indemnification shall not be construed to indemnify the owner for damage arising out of bodily injury to persons or damage to property caused by or resulting from the sole negligence of the owner or its employees.

In consideration of the Town permitting the Special Event, I, for myself, my organization, my executors, administrators, and our respective successors and assignees, do hereby release and discharge the Town & Village of Harrison, and its representatives, officers, employees, agents and successors and assigns from all claims, damages, demands, action and causes of actions whatsoever, in any manner arising growing out of or concerning the special event.

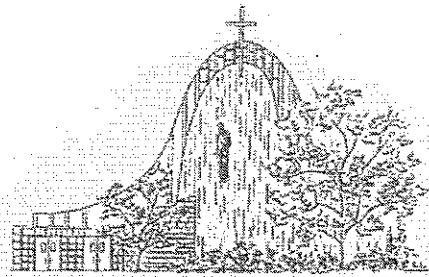

Dear Mayor Belmont:

Each year St. Anthony's Parish holds its Annual Festa Italiana on the first full weekend in June. This year will be our 44th Festa Italiana! I am writing at this time, to seek your assistance during this big event.

We request the following:

➤ **From the Police Department :**

1. The services of Policemen for the following hours:

Friday, June 7	6 p.m. to 12 Midnight
Saturday, June 8	5 p.m. to 12 Midnight
Sunday, June 9	2 p.m. to 10 p.m.

2. And for the Police Guards (after hours)

Friday, June 7	11:30 p.m. to 7:30 a.m.
Saturday, June 8	11:30 p.m. to 7:30 a.m.
Sunday, June 9	9:30 p.m. to 7:30 a.m.

➤ **From the Commissioner of Public Works :**

1. We would like to ask, at this time, for the use of the "large cherry picker". The volunteer electricians will need this vital piece of equipment to insure proper lighting for the many visitors and guests, as well as for the safety of our workers.

Wednesday, June 5th - From approximately 4:30 p.m. until all the lights have been strung. (3-4 hours)

Monday, June 10th - In the morning to take down the lighting.

2. Help in hanging our banners. In the past, they have been hung across Underhill Avenue in West Harrison and either across Harrison Avenue or Halstead Avenue in downtown Harrison.
3. The support of the sanitation staff and the use of the sanitation truck for the weekend. This will insure the safe, clean and efficient operation of our Festa Italiana.
4. The use of the town golf cart during our procession on Sunday, June 9th from approximately 2:30 pm to 6:00 pm
5. The use of the auxillary light tree with generator to use for June 7, 8 and 9th.

We also request that fees associated with any permits that are required by the Town of Harrison be waived. The Town of Harrison has always been very cooperative and extremely helpful in helping St. Anthony's in the past and we hope that this year will be no exception.

Thank you for your cooperation and assistance in helping to make this an enjoyable and safe community affair for everyone to enjoy.
