Attention Residents:

In recent weeks the Town/Village of Harrison Sanitation Department has collected radioactive medical waste from residential properties. Each time this occurs, the Town risks incurring a fine from the County for collecting "unacceptable materials." In addition, the Sanitation truck involved is impounded until such time as the radiation emanating from the truck has dissipated. The waste is then taken to a special recovery facility in Peekskill, where it is ultimately disposed of by County forces.

The time and expense associated with these occurrences is great. In order to prevent these events from recurring, I would like to remind all residents to properly dispose of radioactive materials, including needles and diapers. These items should be disposed of by a qualified medical waste removal company. Also, please keep in mind that these material pose a potential health hazard to our employees by exposing them to radioactive materials and the possibility of needle sticks from contaminated needles.


Supervisor Walsh explained that rumors are always going around.
