Harrison resident Rob Porto thanked Mr. Viscome for his service. Mr. Porto went on to say that there is an open position for an arborist. He opined that it is essential to get someone who is going to try to retain the character of Harrison. He encouraged the Board to hire a person that is a progressive thinker that can learn about tree/root pruning so the sidewalks won't lift up from tree roots.

Councilwoman Amelio asked Commissioner Robinson to come up and explain what the plans are for this position.

Commissioner Robinson began by praising Mr. Viscome. Noting he is a tireless worker and a pleasant gentleman. Explaining that Mr. Viscome wasn't just an arborist; that was his trade. He went to school to be an arborist but Mr. Viscome was a foreman. He was involved in all aspects of the Highway Department. It will be difficult to replace him. If the position is filled from in house, we will have to rely on someone who has experience with the tree crews but not necessarily an arborist. There can be consideration to whomever we decide to pick, to send them to classes to gain that ability.

Returning to Mr. Viscome, the Commissioner went on to say Mr. Viscome was in charge of our Health and Safety Program. He provided training for Stormwater Management, something that is mandated by the State. He performed our fire extinguisher inspections and our in house training programs. We are going to have to try hard to fill his position because it comprised a myriad of tasks. The Commissioner gave him a hardy thank you and wished him all the best in whatever he chooses to do.

Councilwoman Amelio said without a doubt Mr. Viscome wore many hats and he wore them effectively. She agreed that Mr. Porto's comment about maintaining the appearance of the Town had merit. She noted that she and the Commissioner spoke recently about efforts to replace trees with those that aren't so fast growing that will still benefit a neighborhood.

Commissioner Robinson said that he has completed several recent sidewalk projects with Town Engineer, Mike Amodio's assistance. He's gone to a landscape architect and selected several species of trees. These trees do not have a large outward growth of leaves and the roots grow down.

Councilwoman Amelio said this information is all very helpful. Many of our residents are unaware of the efforts that we are taking to assure the proper growth of trees and the Town's replanting program.

Councilman Malfitano noted that Mr. Viscome's history of service to the Town goes back to the water authority, District 1, in West Harrison. When the Town merged the district with the Westchester Joint Water Works, Mr. Viscome went to work for them for a couple of years. He then he came back to the Town. It was Mr. Viscome's idea that we consider adding a position that would address what Mr. Porto was talking about earlier. Given Mr. Viscome's background and experience, he was the perfect person for the position. Councilman Malfitano made a point to recognize that it was Mr. Viscome's concept that the Town consider instituting a program for which Mr. Viscome was eventually hired. Mr. Malfitano thanked Mr. Viscome for his many years of service to the town.

Supervisor Belmont said he wanted to add that Mr. Viscome is a friend, a real gentleman, and the go to guy when it came to trees in the town and being a true arborist in every sense of the word.
